

Merrylee Treasure Hunt

Follow the route, solve the clues, and choose your wee treasure at the end!

Start here:

Begin under the archway at the front of the path leading up to Cathcart Baptist Church from the main road.

Instruction 1

Facing the road, turn left and walk just beyond the School Patrol sign.

Clues 1 and 2 are both nearby.

Clue 1



Find the first initial from each word to cross off a location on the map.

Clue 2



Subtract the second number from the first. This is the first part of a grid reference for a location on the map. You'll need the second part before you can cross this off.

Instruction 2

Find a safe place to cross the road. Then walk to the lane opposite Merrylee Parish Church.

Heads up to find this next clue – before you go down the lane.

Clue 3



Can you work out what this building is? Both its name and signage should help you rule out another location from the map.

Instruction 3

Head down the lane.

Go carefully, you don't want to go red with embarrassment if you trip up on the next clue!

Clue 4



Look around and check the speed limit to find the second part of the grid reference mentioned in clue 2. You can now use the two parts of the reference to eliminate a location from your map.

Instruction 4

Look up and find the wind turbine – keep it on your left as you walk towards clue 5.

Clue 5



When you spot this logo, you'll see 'Reel Time' is mixed up. But this will help you work out where on the map to cross off next.

Instruction 5

Continue down Friarton Rd. Looking towards the school should keep you *growing* in the right direction!

Clue 6



Growing plants is good for the environment. Look around, can you see another eco-friendly action? If you want to keep it safe, you'll need something extra. This extra item sounds a bit like a location on the map for you to cross off!

Instruction 6

Carry on along Friarton Road as far as the mini-roundabout by Merrylee Playpark.

Turn right.

Walk past three lamp posts and look around for the next clue.

Clue 7



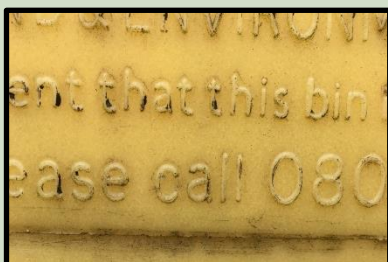
'Try' not to get distracted by events as you count how many of these are in a vertical line. Use what you find to cross off the next location.

Instruction 7

Carry on up the road, passing a road on your right and then a large sycamore tree and road on your left.

The next clue can be found just past the fork in the pavement.

Clue 8



You'll need some grit to work this place out. Cross off the location that contains this clue.

Instruction 8

Just beyond the no-through-road sign, you'll be able to spot this next clue!

Clue 9



Without able, what remains? It might be more than you think when you find those letters at a location on the map.

Instruction 9

Start climbing the hill towards Ashmore Road to find the next clue.

Watch your step!

Clue 10



What would you get from here?
Probably comes from a location on the map that you can cross off!

Instruction 10

Carry on walking up the road towards Ashmore Road and cross at the top. Stand under the street sign and look back the way you came – facing North East.

Can you spot the next clue?

Clue 11

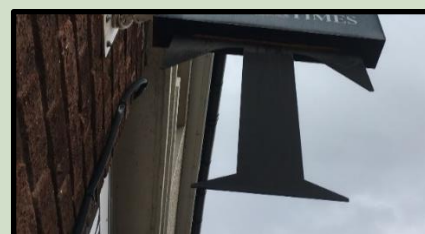


You'll need to look closely to see these letters. Add **b e m o a n** to them. A good mix will find another location to eliminate.

Instruction 11

Head North-West from the street sign post – you might need to queue at the shop for the next clue!

Clue 12



Find the words on this sign and you won't be too late to cross off another location!

Instruction 12

Find the red post box – the clue might strike you!

Clue 13



Proceed with caution as you look around here for the next location to cross off. Your generosity should lead you – but if you get an injury you'll end up there anyway!

Instruction 13

Retrace your steps to go back along Ashmore Road, up and over the hill but not to the end of the road and look for the next clue.

Clue 14



What do they do here? But it rains so much in Glasgow - they must have an indoor alternative! Find one on the map and cross it off.

Instruction 14

Continue to the corner. Don't cross the bridge or you'll miss the point!

Clue 15



These rocky outposts offer safe passage to the community – the next location to cross off might also have something solid to deliver.

Instruction 15

Turn right, keeping the railway on your left.

Follow the black iron fence to the next clue.

Clue 16



Remove two fat ladies from this number to reveal the next location to be eliminated.

Instruction 16

Return to Cathcart Baptist Church grounds by carrying on along the road, around the curve, taking the first road on the left, and turning right at the bottom of the hill. Once back at the church, follow the path to find clue 17.

Clue 17



This may be locked – but it isn't the only way through. Search for another opening right here - and find a location that rhymes with it to cross off the map.

Instruction 17

You're really close to the last clue!

Look around and you will find it for sure.

Clue 18



Don't spare the horses – you've almost reached victory! Rearrange the letters found on this sign to eliminate the final location.

You've reached the end – Hooray!

There should only be one place left on the map now.

Look around you to find somewhere nearby that matches the remaining location name.

The treasure is there for all to see - claim your gem of a stone – everyone can take one home with them!
